RULES AND AGREEMENT FOR BUILDER PARTICIPATION

- Builder agrees to pay a fee of \$500, which will go directly to the Chef that they are paired up with to help cover the cost of food, supplies and labor. There is no restriction on paying more than the minimum fee, but this will be up to the sole discretion of the Builder.
- Builders are encouraged to partner with a Chef/Restaurant with whom or with which they have a personal relationship with. If the Builder does not have a Chef in mind, OMB will provide a suggested list and/or pair Builders up with Chefs, based on availability.
- Chef selection is based upon a first-come, first-serve process.
- Builders must enter the Tour and provide an accurate address for their home by August 3rd, 2018 to be considered as a Chefs on Tour home.
- Attendees must remove their shoes and/or wear booties when entering homes. OMB will provide booties.
- Attendees must be 18 year of age or older.
- Attendees must have an official Chefs on Tour ticket to take part in the event.
- Homes must be staffed during the Chefs event.
- Builders MUST:
 - Provide an oven, stovetop and refrigerator for Chef use.
 - Provide at least one large table for serving purposes.
 - Provide one small wastebasket for trash made during food preparation.
 - Provide one large trash can for waste from the public.
 - Remove all trash from the event prior to the home opening to the public the following day.
 - Meet with the Chef on a date that is mutually agreed upon. The Builder and Chef will visit the home at this meeting and determine where the food will be served, what portions of the kitchen may be used, and other administrative details of the event.
- It is strongly suggested that Builders provide:
 - Some seating, ideally outdoors, with a backup plan in case of inclement weather.
 - Some tables, with or without seating, for the public to rest food and drinks on.
 - Some form of entertainment, whether it is live music or radio/cd's, is up to the Builder.
 - A "theme" for guests to enjoy, including themed food.
- Builders may determine if they want wine or beer samples served at their homes. OMB must be notified before any arrangements are made with a winery, brewery or other provider. Alcohol samples may only be given when the Builder approves, and appropriate certification from the State is obtained. If the Chef does not have an off-site liquor license, OMB will obtain a permit for them.
- OMB will provide a cleaning service for ONLY the first floor of the homes on the Chefs tour. The cleaning service will do its best to restore the home to pre-Chefs condition, but it is the ultimate responsibility of the Builder to ensure the home is clean and ready for its next opening. If a Builder continues to entertain in the home after the Chefs event concludes, then the Builder is responsible for all cleaning. Homes will be cleaned prior to the start of the Tour of Homes, at a date and time to be determined. THIS IS MANDATORY.
- **Participant agrees to hold harmless and to indemnify OMB from and against any and all claims by any and all persons and/or other legal entity(ies) arising from, or in any way related to, the Chef's participation in the 2018 Chefs on Tour. This indemnity agreement includes but is not limited to any third party claims or actions against OMB or any other claims, crossclaims or third-party claims by any party who may believe that OMB is in any way liable for damages allegedly sustained as the result of Builder participation in the 2018 Chefs on Tour.**
- All participants will be listed in the Tour of Homes guide, as well as select marketing associated with the event.
- All rules listed in the 2018 Tour of Homes agreement also apply to the Chefs on Tour event.
