- 2. **Two letters of recommendation** from persons who will describe qualifications that make you a logical choice for one of the OMB Education Foundation scholarships. At least two letters should be from people who interact with you in your professional life: supervisors, volunteer coordinators, co-workers, counselor, etc.
- 3. **Academic transcript** an unofficial copy from the last two semesters, three quarters, or a copy of your most recent transcript.
- 4. A career goals written essay (250 words minimum), OR provide a link to a three minute video discussing your career goals.

Any required information not included in the application packet will disqualify the applicant.

Applications must be postmarked no later than than Friday, April 12, 2024.
