The County Manager Seat is up for Election!

The county manager will set the tone and vision for the county well into the future. The county's choice for the next county manager could have major impacts on the future of homebuilding in Lewis County.

The finalists are:

- **Ryan Barrett** has more than 19 years of public service in Lewis and King counties. He is currently employed as a Captain for South Correctional Entity, a regional correctional facility in Des Moines, Wash. Barrett, who spent more than seven years with the Lewis County Sheriff's Office working as a Corrections Deputy and Lieutenant, has a Master of Business Administration from Western Governors University in Millcreek, Utah, and a Bachelor in Business Communication from Evergreen State College in Olympia, Wash.
- **Gun-Sam Kim** began his

public service career with the U.S. Navy from 1985 to 1987. After a tour in the Navy, he became Chief IT Operations Officer with Santa Clara County, Calif. He has been the Chief Information Officer for Washington County in Hillsboro, Ore., since 2020. Kim holds a Master of Science in Engineering and Master of Mathematical Finance.
