

If you are selected as one of the top candidates, you may be required to appear for an interview to be considered for the scholarship.

You must submit the following items to complete your application packet:

1. **This Scholarship Application Form** with required additional information. Please fill in all blanks completely or mark with N/A if not applicable. Information is strictly confidential.
2. **Two letters of recommendation** from persons who will describe qualifications that make you a logical choice for one of the OMB Education Foundation scholarships. At least two letters should be from people who interact with you in your professional life: supervisors, volunteer coordinators, co-workers, counselor, etc.
3. **Academic transcript** an unofficial copy from the last two semesters, three quarters, or a copy of your most recent transcript.
4. **A career goals written essay** (250 words minimum), OR provide a link to a three minute video discussing your career goals.

Any required information not included in the application packet will disqualify the applicant.

Applications must be postmarked no later than **Wednesday, May 27, 2026**.

Evaluation Criteria

Applicants will be judged according to the following criteria:

Upon OMB Education Foundation receiving school and student information, scholarship checks will be issued to the school of student's choice. Scholarship awards are made for one academic year only and must be used within 12 months of being awarded or they are forfeited.
